Dear Master Swimmers,

On Monday 24th November, 2003, a number of us are swimming (collectively) a distance equivalent to the English Channel, 22 miles or 35kms. This will take place at the Lions pool during our normal workout, to raise money for a little girl from Ipswich in the UK called Terri Calvesbert, who suffered 90% burns in a house fire. Terri has had 16 operations in 3 years and will have operations every year for the rest of her life. She is effectively in an artificial skin/grafted skin body suit that requires constant surgery as she grows.

This swim will be one of many swims being held around the world to raise money for Terri's trust fund. Please join us in the Cayman Islands effort.

If you would like to be part of this amazing fundraiser for Terri we would like to charge the normal workout fee + \$17.00 (\$20.00 total). A separate sign-in sheet for this event will be available on the date Monday 24th November. Also, if you are not able to swim and would like to contribute to the event we have allowed for this as well. Any amount you give will ALL go to Terri's trust fund.
